ORDER NISI

Upon this matter coming up for hearing and determination before His Worship **B.H. ABE (MRS)** sitting at Chief Magistrate Court 1, Rumuodomaya, on **Thursday the 20th day of August, 2026**, after hearing from the counsels to the Applicant, E. U. Ikechukwu, Esq.;

THE COURT ORDERED AS FOLLOWS;

1. That a Garnishee Order Nisi is hereby issued by this Court, attaching the money belonging to the Judgment Debtors with the Garnishees in the sum of ₦850,000.00 (Eight Hundred and Fifty Thousand Naira) only.
2. That the Garnishees disclose forthwith the outstanding sum belonging to the Judgment Debtors still with the Garnishees and that such disclosure should be made on oath, verified by an affidavit and filed before this Honourable Court.
3. That the Garnishees appear before this Honourable Court on the next adjourned date or as may be directed by the Court to show cause (if any) why an order should not be made upon it for the payment of the sum due and owing or accruing from the Garnishees to the said Judgment Debtor or so much thereof as will satisfy the said sum of ₦850,000.00 (Eight Hundred and Fifty Thousand Naira) being the judgment sums from the Judgment delivered on the 21st May, 2025 by this Honourable Court.
4. That the sum of ₦500,000.00 (Five Hundred Thousand Naira) only, being and representing the costs incurred by the Judgment Creditor/Applicant in the prosecution of this Garnishee proceedings, be paid by the judgment debtors to the judgment creditor.
5. That the Garnishee Banks disclose all account details of the judgment debtors or any other customer bearing similar names.
6. That this Order Nisi operates to restrain the Garnishee Banks from allowing any sum howsoever to be transferred and/or withdrawn in any manner whatsoever from any of the accounts belonging to the judgment debtors, maintained in that name howsoever described with the said Garnishees, unless the judgment debt and costs have been duly satisfied by the judgment debtors.
7. That failure to appear in obedience to the Order Nisi within 14 days of service of this order on the Garnishee Banks will lead the Court to make the Order Nisi Absolute, against the defaulting Garnishee Bank.
